4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska increasing the mem-
7 bership of each chamber of the legislature.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. Article II, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE POWER; MEMBERSHIP. The legislative power of
12 the State is vested in a legislature consisting of a senate with a mem-
13 bership of twenty-five [TWENTY] and a house of representatives with a
14 membership of fifty-one [FORTY].

15 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before
16 the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with art.
17 XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of
18 the state.
