5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska eliminating certain
7 restrictions on former legislators'
8 holding offices or positions of profit in
9 government.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Article II, sec. 5, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
12 amended to read:

13 SECTION 5. QUALIFICATIONS. No legislator may hold any other
14 office or position of profit under the United States or the State.
15 During the term for which elected [AND FOR ONE YEAR THEREAFTER], no
16 legislator may be nominated, elected, or appointed to any other office
17 or position of profit which has been created, or the salary or emolu-
18 ments of which have been increased, while he was a member. This section
19 shall not prevent any person from seeking or holding the office of
20 governor, lieutenant governor [SECRETARY OF STATE], or member of Con-
21 gress. This section shall not apply to employment by or election to a
22 constitutional convention.

23 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed be-
24 fore the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with
25 art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws
26 of the state.
