5 Relating to the North Slope Haul Road.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

7 WHEREAS construction of the trans-Alaska oil pipeline is almost com-
8 pleted; and

9 WHEREAS, upon cessation of construction activities, the haul road to the
10 North Slope could be operated by the state as a public highway; and

11 WHEREAS enacting legislation granting authority and providing appro-
12 priations may be necessary before the state can operate the haul road as a
13 public highway;

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that it respectfully
15 requests the Governor to (1) include in his recommended budget for fiscal
16 year 1979 any amounts needed for maintenance and patrolling of the North
17 Slope Haul Road on a year-round basis; (2) introduce in the Second Session of
18 the Tenth Legislature, no later than February 1, 1978, any legislation re-
19 quired to enable the state to open the haul road to the public and maintain
20 it on a year-round basis; and (3) identify any restrictions imposed on state
21 governmental activity vis a vis the haul road as a result of federal involve-
22 ment in construction of the road.
