2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 18

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the Susitna power project.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

7 WHEREAS in recent weeks the state and nation have paused to mourn the  
8 passing of U. S. Senator Hubert Horatio Humphrey; and

9 WHEREAS Senator Humphrey recognized as early as 1960 the tremendous  
10 potential of hydroelectric power in Alaska, hailing it as "one of the greatest  
11 of all Alaska resources"; and

12 WHEREAS the Susitna power project, designed to generate 6.91 billion  
13 kilowatts of electricity a year upon completion, is a project of a magnitude  
14 equal to Senator Humphrey's vision; and

15 WHEREAS the state-federal cooperation in planning and financing major  
16 hydroelectric projects made possible by the enactment of ch. 278 SLA 1976  
17 would have been supported by Senator Humphrey;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State House of Representatives that the  
19 810-foot dam proposed to be constructed 31 miles upstream from Devils Canyon  
20 be named the Hubert Horatio Humphrey Dam.

21 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Muriel Humphrey,  
22 U. S. Senate; and the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel,  
23 U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U. S. Representative, members of  
24 the Alaska delegation in Congress.
