6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to licenses for sale of alcoholic
7 beverages."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.200 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.200. PUBLIC NOTICE. The board shall provide by regu-
11 lation for adequate notice to inform the public and the local governing
12 body of a proposed issuance of a new license, renewal or transfer of an
13 existing license. The notice shall be bilingual when necessary.
14 Notice shall be given by posting at the location of the premises, at the
15 nearest post office, and at one other conspicuous location in the area
16 for a period of at least 10 days a true copy of the application and by
17 public service announcements provided to newspapers and radio and tele-
18 vision stations at least 30 days before filing the application. Paid
19 notices by the applicant may not be required by the board under this
20 section except when the board determines the public interest requires
21 those notices for establishments not located within organized boroughs
22 or within unified municipalities.
