BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 46.03.320(b) is amended to read:

(b) The department may provide by regulation for the licensing of

11

private applicators of restricted-use pesticides and for persons engaged

12

in the custom, commercial or contract spraying or application of pesti-

13

cides and broadcast chemicals. A person engaged in the custom, commer-

14

cial, or contract spraying or application of pesticides and broadcast

15

chemicals may, by regulation, be required to secure a surety bond or

16

liability insurance [INCLUDING THE REQUIREMENT OF A SURETY BOND AND

17

LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE LICENSEE].

(23) "restricted-use pesticides" means pesticides that are
