7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 34.50.020(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) A person, municipal corporation, association, village, school
10 district or religious or charitable organization, incorporated or unin-
11 corporated, may recover damages in a civil action in an amount not to
12 exceed \$5,000, attorney's fees [\$2,000] and court costs, from either
13 parent or both parents or the legal guardian or person having the legal
14 custody of an unemancipated minor under the age of 18 years, who mali-
15 ciously or wilfully destroys real or personal property belonging to the
16 person, municipal corporation, association, village, school district or
17 religious or charitable organization.

19 Sec. 45.05.104. THIRD-PARTY BENEFICIARIES OF WARRANTIES EXPRESS OR
20 IMPLIED. A seller's warranty whether express or implied extends to any
21 [A NATURAL] person who may reasonably be expected to [IS IN THE FAMILY
22 OR HOUSEHOLD OF HIS BUYER OR WHO IS A GUEST IN HIS HOME IF IT IS REASON-
23 ABLE TO EXPECT THAT THE PERSON MAY] use, consume, or be affected by the
24 goods and who is injured [IN PERSON] by breach of the warranty. A
25 seller may not exclude or limit the operation of this section.
