6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to renunciation of succession under
7 the Uniform Probate Code."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 13.11.295(f) is amended to read:

10 (f) An interest in property existing on the effective date of
11 this Act as to which [, IF A PRESENT INTEREST,] the time for filing a
12 renunciation under this section would have begun to run if this section
13 were in effect when the interest was created [HAS NOT EXPIRED, OR, IF
14 A FUTURE INTEREST, THE INTEREST HAS NOT BECOME INDEFEASIBLY VESTED OR
15 THE TAKER FINALLY ASCERTAINED,] may be renounced within six months
16 after the effective date of this Act.

17 * Sec. 2. In sec. 1 of this Act, AS 13.11.295(f)'s reference to "effec-
18 tive date of this Act" means this Act and not ch. 154 SLA 1976 where that
19 phrase first appeared.
