6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the New
7 Capital Site Planning Commission; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The amount of \$156,859 is appropriated from the general fund
11 to the new Capital Site Planning Commission to fund the operating expenses of
12 the commission through December 31, 1978.

13 * Sec. 2. The amount of \$1,049,000 is appropriated from the general fund
14 to the New Capital Site Planning Commission to fund environmental impact
15 assessment projects relating to the new capital site.

16 * Sec. 3. (a) The amount of \$3,712,937 is appropriated from the general
17 fund to the New Capital Site Planning Commission to be allocated as follows:

18	New Capital Site Planning Commission and the	
19	Alaska Capital City Development Corporation	
20	operating expenses	\$1,280,287
21	Environmental impact assessment projects	2,432,650

22 (b) The funds appropriated in this section constitute a loan from the
23 general fund which shall be reimbursed from funds available to the Alaska
24 Capital City Development Corporation. The appropriation for environmental
25 impact assessment projects shall be repaid from the proceeds of the first
26 sale of the bonds authorized by the voters for costs of relocation of the
27 capital.

28 * Sec. 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect July 1, 1978. Section
29 3 of this Act takes effect December 5, 1978 provided that a bond issue for

1 costs of relocation of the capital has been adopted by the voters of the
2 state.
