6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to general relief assistance."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 47.25.130 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 47.25.130. AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE. The amount of assistance
10 for a needy person shall be determined by the department with regard to
11 the resources and needs of the person and the conditions existing in
12 each case. Where possible, assistance shall be sufficient to provide
13 the applicant with reasonable subsistence according to standards of
14 assistance established by the department. However, the amount of assis-
15 tance for subsistence needs may not exceed \$250 [\$80] a person a calen-
16 dar month, except, when amounts for assistance to recipients under this
17 title are increased by operation of sec. 215(i) of the Social Security
18 Act (42 U.S.C. 415(i)) as a result of an increase in the cost of living,
19 the amount of assistance allowed under this section shall be increased
20 by an equal percentage.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 47.25.250 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 47.25.250. TEMPORARY RELIEF. When a needy person is not
23 entitled to assistance under secs. 120 - 300 of this chapter and has no
24 relatives in the state liable for his support under secs. 230 and 240 of
25 this chapter, the needy person may receive temporary assistance in the
26 form and amount which the department considers necessary. Temporary
27 assistance for needs other than transportation and medical care may not
28 exceed \$250 [\$80] per person per month, except, when amounts for assis-
29 tance to recipients under this title are increased by operation of sec.

1 215(i) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 415(i)) as a result of an
2 increase in the cost of living, the amount of assistance allowed under
3 this section shall be increased by an equal percentage.
