5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bidding on highway projects valued
7 at less than \$20,000."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19.10.190 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 19.10.190. ADVERTISEMENT, BIDS, CONTRACTS, AND INFORMAL BIDS.

11 (a) Except as provided in AS 44.33.300, when the estimated cost of any
12 construction exceeds \$20,000, the department shall, except as provided
13 in sec. 170 of this chapter, proceed to advertise, request bids, and
14 award the contract in the manner provided in secs. 200 and 210 of this
15 chapter. Whenever any proposed construction contract is for a sum less
16 than \$20,000, it is [SHALL BE] discretionary with the department whether
17 the contract is to [SHALL] be advertised and awarded in accordance with
18 secs. 200 and 210 of this chapter.

19 (b) When immediate repairs, maintenance, or materials are needed
20 for a timely completion of a maintenance contract, repair contract,
21 building repair materials contract, or road maintenance contract for a
22 sum less than \$20,000, it is discretionary with the department, AS 37.-
23 05.230 notwithstanding, whether the contract is to be advertised and
24 awarded in accordance with secs. 200 and 210 of this chapter.

25 (c) In applying either (a) or (b) of this section [ALL EVENTS] the
26 department shall request informal bids from as many contractors as can
27 be requested conveniently.
