8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 (c) The instructional unit allotment established in (a) of this
10 section for any school district which does not have access to Anchorage,
11 Ketchikan or Fairbanks by road, railroad or Alaska State Ferry System
12 is increased, [SHALL BE INCREASED AN ADDITIONAL FIVE PER CENT] above its
13 instructional unit allotment under (a)(1) - (8) of this section, as
14 follows:

15 (1) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
16 scribed in (a)(1) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
17 increased by an additional 1.875 per cent;

18 (2) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
19 scribed in (a)(2) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
20 increased by an additional 3.750 per cent;

21 (3) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
22 scribed in (a)(3) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
23 increased by an additional 5.625 per cent;

24 (4) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
25 scribed in (a)(4) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
26 increased by an additional 7.500 per cent;

27 (5) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
28 scribed in (a)(5) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
29 increased by an additional 9.375 per cent;

1 (6) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
2 scribed in (a)(6) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
3 increased by an additional 11.250 per cent;

4 (7) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
5 scribed in (a)(7) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
6 increased by an additional 13.125 per cent;

7 (8) if the district or area is in that part of the state de-
8 scribed in (a)(8) of this section, its instructional unit allotment is
9 increased by an additional 15.000 per cent.
