6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fraudulent use of credit cards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.22.070 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.22.070. FRAUDULENT USE OF A CREDIT CARD. (a) A person,
10 who, with intent to defraud the issuer or a person providing money,
11 goods, services or anything else of value, or any other person, (1) uses
12 for the purpose of obtaining money, goods, services or anything else of
13 value a credit card obtained or retained in violation of secs. 10 - 60
14 of this chapter or a credit card which he knows is forged, expired or
15 revoked, or (2) obtains money, goods, services or anything else of value
16 by representing without the consent of the cardholder that he is the
17 holder of a specified card or by representing that he is the holder of
18 a card and the card has not in fact been issued, is guilty of a mis-
19 demeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for a term
20 not to exceed one year, or by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by both,
21 if the aggregate value of all money, goods, services and other things of
22 value obtained in violation of this subsection does not exceed \$500 in
23 any six-month period.

24 (b) If the aggregate value does exceed \$500 in any six-month
25 period, the person is guilty of a felony, and upon conviction, is punish-
26 able by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than three years, or
27 by a fine not to exceed \$3,000, or by both.

28 * Sec. 2. AS 11.22.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

29 (c) A person who, with intent to injure or defraud the issuer or

1 cardholder, forges another's name while using a lost or stolen credit
2 card, regardless of the accumulated value of goods or services obtained,
3 is guilty of a felony and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment
4 for not less than one nor more than three years, or by a fine not to
5 exceed \$3,000 or by both.
