6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the authority of the Alaska Trans-
7 portation Commission over joint carrier agreements."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.10.070 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

10 (6) shall regulate and approve agreements between common
11 carriers relating to fares, rates, classifications, divisions, allowances,
12 and charges, including charges between carriers and compensation paid or
13 received for the use of facilities and equipment; however, the commission
14 may not approve

15 (A) an agreement between a common carrier by highway and
16 a common carrier by rail, water, or air unless it is limited to
17 matters relating to transportation under joint rates or over through
18 routes;

19 (B) an agreement which permits the pooling or division
20 of traffic, service, or earnings;

21 (C) an agreement which establishes a procedure for the
22 determination of a matter through joint consideration unless it
23 finds that there is accorded to each party the free and unrestrained
24 right to take independent action either before or after a determina-
25 tion arrived at through such a procedure.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 42.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

27 Sec. 42.10.075. EXEMPTION FROM ANTI-TRUST LAW. Collective action
28 carried out under an agreement approved by the commission under sec.
29 70(6) of this chapter is exempt from the provisions of AS 45.52.
