A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to occupational safety and health; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.60.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) The department shall surrender to the appropriate federal
11 agency the responsibility for development and enforcement of occupa-
12 tional safety and health standards with respect to which a federal
13 standard has been adopted under 29 U.S.C. 655 (P.L. 91-596).

14 * Sec. 2. AS 18.60.030(6) is amended to read:

15 (6) establish and enforce occupational safety and health
16 standards that prescribe requirements for safe and healthful working
17 conditions for all employment, including state and local government em-
18 ployment [, AND THE REQUIREMENTS ARE TO BE AT LEAST AS EFFECTIVE AS
19 THOSE REQUIREMENTS PROMULGATED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF LABOR
20 UNDER SEC. 6 OF PUBLIC LAW 91-596];

21 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1977.
