5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the Alaska longevity bonus; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.45.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person who is 65 years of age or over, who was domiciled in
11 the territory on or before January 3, 1959 and who has maintained a
12 continuous domicile in the territory or state for 25 years may apply to
13 the commissioner of administration for qualification to receive a monthly
14 bonus of \$150 [\$125].

15 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1978.
