6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the suspension and removal of
7 judges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.30.070(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) On recommendation of the commission or on its own motion, the
11 supreme court may suspend a judge from office without salary from the
12 date on which [WHEN] in the United States he is charged in court with
13 [PLEADS GUILTY OR NO CONTEST OR IS FOUND GUILTY OF] a crime punishable
14 as a felony under Alaska or federal law or of any other crime that
15 involves moral turpitude under that law. If he is found not guilty or
16 his conviction is reversed, suspension terminates, and he shall be paid
17 his salary for the period of suspension. If he is suspended and his
18 conviction becomes final the supreme court shall remove him from office.
