6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the suspension and removal of
7 judges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.30.070(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) On recommendation of the commission or on its own motion, the
11 supreme court may suspend a judge from office without salary from the
12 date on which [WHEN] in the United States he is charged in court with
13 [PLEADS GUILTY OR NO CONTEST OR IS FOUND GUILTY OF] a crime punishable
14 as a felony under Alaska or federal law or of any other crime that
15 involves moral turpitude under either [THAT] law. If he is found not
16 guilty or his conviction is reversed, suspension terminates, and he
17 shall be paid his salary for the period of suspension. If he is sus-
18 pended and his conviction becomes final the supreme court shall remove
19 him from office.
