6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judicial officers; and providing  
7 for an effective date.

8 "BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.30.070(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) On recommendation of the commission or on its own motion, the  
11 supreme court may suspend a judge from office without salary from the  
12 date on which [WHEN] in the United States he pleads guilty or no contest  
13 or a verdict of guilty is returned against him for [IS FOUND GUILTY OF]  
14 a crime punishable as a felony under Alaska or federal law or of any  
15 other crime that involves moral turpitude under that law. If the  
16 verdict is set aside or if his conviction is reversed, suspension ter-  
17 minates, and he shall be paid his salary for the period of suspension.  
18 If he is suspended and his conviction becomes final the supreme court  
19 shall remove him from office.

20 \* Sec. 2. AS 12.35.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

21 (b) Whenever property is solely sought under (a)(4) of this section,  
22 is not contraband, and is in the possession of a person not suspected  
23 of a crime, search warrants based solely upon (a)(4) of this section  
24 shall be issued only upon a showing of probable cause based on facts  
25 presented in a sworn affidavit that a subpoena or restraining order  
26 would be impracticable or would not effectively prevent the property  
27 sought from being destroyed, concealed or removed from the jurisdiction.
