6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to membership on the Alaska Code
7 Commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 *Section 1. AS 24.20.075(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The commission consists of two legislators, one from each
11 house, appointed by the presiding officer; one public member, who is
12 not an employee of the state government, appointed by the governor; a
13 designee of the governor, who is an attorney employed by the executive
14 branch of the state government; a designee of the chief justice of the
15 supreme court; and a designee of the Alaska Bar Association appointed
16 by the board of governors of the association. Legislative members
17 serve at the pleasure of the presiding officer, and appointed members
18 serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority. Members receive
19 the standard per diem for board members, or the regular legislative
20 per diem if they are legislators, for days spent on commission business.
21 The commission selects its chairman and vice-chairman. The director
22 of legal services for the Legislative Affairs Agency, or his designee,
23 serves as executive secretary for the commission.
