6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of subsistence-caught
7 fish eggs; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Section 4, ch. 99, SLA 1975 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 4. Sections 1(a) and 2 of this Act expire January 1, 1978
11 [1977].

12 * Sec. 2. The Department of Fish and Game shall, no later than January 10,
13 1978, recommend to the legislature that the sale of subsistence caught salmon
14 eggs be permitted or prohibited. The individualized recommendations for each
15 fishing unit or subunit shall be supported by factual documentation. The
16 Department of Public Safety shall assist in gathering the documentation.

17 * Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act is retroactive to January 1, 1977.

18 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
19 070(c).
