7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.560(f) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (f) Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring a  
10 school board to negotiate with its supervisory employees.

11 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.560 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (g) In this section, a "supervisory" employee includes the chief  
13 administrator, principals and assistant principals, and any central  
14 office certificated staff having authority, in the interest of the em-  
15 ployer, to recommend the hire, transfer, suspension, lay-off, promotion,  
16 discharge, assignment, reward, or discipline of other employees.
