6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a compulsory free enterprise instruc-
7 tion program in public high schools; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. As 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 ARTICLE 5. FREE ENTERPRISE INSTRUCTION.

12 Sec. 14.30.500. FREE ENTERPRISE INSTRUCTION. (a) All public high
13 schools shall give instruction on the essentials and benefits of the
14 free enterprise system in which each student shall participate as a
15 prerequisite to graduation. A free enterprise instruction program shall
16 be provided under a plan of service which has been developed under
17 regulations adopted by the department.

18 (b) As used in (a) of this section "free enterprise" means an
19 economic system characterized by private or corporate ownership of
20 capital goods, by investments that are determined by private decision
21 rather than state control, and by prices, production and the distri-
22 bution of goods that are determined in a free manner.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
