BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 22.05.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10

(c) The supreme court has jurisdiction to render opinions on im-  
11 portant questions of law submitted to the court by either house of the  
12 legislature or by the governor. The court shall notify the houses of  
13 the legislature and the governor promptly of the filing of a request for  
14 an opinion under this subsection and may accept briefs on behalf of the  
15 legislature, a house of the legislature, the governor, or other inter-  
16 ested persons, which address the questions submitted.
