6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the jurisdiction of the supreme
7 court; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 22.05.012. ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OF THE SUPREME COURT. The
11 supreme court has discretionary and original but not exclusive juris-
12 diction of controversies between the governor and the legislature.

13 Sec. 22.05.013. PARTIES TO ORIGINAL ACTIONS BEFORE THE SUPREME
14 COURT. Actions may be brought in the supreme court under sec. 12 of
15 this chapter by

16 (1) The governor, in his own behalf or in behalf of any
17 department, division or official within the executive branch; or

18 (2) The legislature, after passage of a concurrent resolution
19 approving such action, or, during recesses or adjournments of the legis-
20 lature, by the Legislative Council in behalf of and in the name of the
21 legislature after approval of such action by a majority vote of the
22 Legislative Council.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
