7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 08.12.070 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 08.12.070. APPLICATION. A person wishing to practice barber-  
10 ing shall apply to the board for a license. An applicant for a license  
11 shall

12 (1) be of good moral character;

13 (2) have completed instruction and training of at least 1,500  
14 hours in a barber school or college approved by the board;

15 (3) submit with his application a certificate of health from  
16 a physician; and

17 (4) submit other information required under regulations  
18 adopted by the board.
