6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the requirement that nonresident
7 hunters be accompanied by guides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue or take
11 moose, caribou, musk oxen, brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear or sheep
12 in this state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed
13 as a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the department
14 or who is personally accompanied by a resident Alaskan over 19 years of
15 age who is the spouse of or is related by blood within and including the
16 second degree of kindred. A person who applies for a nonresident big
17 game tag for the taking of an animal specified in this section shall
18 first furnish to the state, on a form provided by the state, an affi-
19 davit showing that he will be accompanied in his hunt by a person who is
20 qualified under the terms of this section. A person who falsifies the
21 required affidavit is guilty of perjury.
