6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to medical leave."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 39.20.260(f) is amended to read:

9 (f) Upon his separation from state service, other than by retire-
10 ment and unless he reenters employment of the state within six months of
11 his termination, the unused medical leave of an officer or employee is
12 automatically canceled without pay for it. If the employee is subse-
13 quently reemployed within one year by the state, the employee is en-
14 titled to have reinstated in full the sick leave he had accumulated at
15 the time of his last termination [AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE WHEN TERMINATED
16 BY THE STATE REENTERS THE STATE SERVICE WITHIN SIX MONTHS AFTER HIS
17 TERMINATION, HE IS ENTITLED TO CREDIT FOR ONE-HALF OF THE MEDICAL LEAVE
18 HE HAD ACCRUED AT THE TIME OF HIS TERMINATION].

19 * Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (g) Upon retirement, an employee shall receive cash payment for
21 50 per cent of his accumulated medical leave. For purposes of deter-
22 mining the payment, the employee's medical leave shall be computed at
23 the same rate of pay as his salary on retirement.
