6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to geological, geophysical and en-  
7 gineering data."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 5A. PERMITS AND FILING OF DATA.

11 Sec. 38.05.133. PERMITS. (a) No person may undertake to obtain  
12 geological, geophysical and engineering data on state land without first  
13 obtaining a permit for the purpose.

14 (b) Upon submission of an application by a person, the director  
15 shall issue a permit for the purpose of obtaining geological, geophysical  
16 and engineering data on state land.

17 Sec. 38.05.134. FILING OF DATA. (a) A permit issued under sec.  
18 133 of this chapter shall

19 (1) include provisions that all geological, geophysical and  
20 engineering data be filed with the division of lands at the completion  
21 of a survey;

22 (2) provide that all geological, geophysical and engineering  
23 data shall remain confidential for a period of 90 days;

24 (3) stipulate that after the 90-day confidentiality period  
25 all geological, geophysical and engineering data be turned over to the  
26 division of geological survey and shall be considered public information.
