7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.43.160 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 nual renewal of entry permits are as follows:

(b) Fees collected under this section shall be paid into the general fund.

(c) The holder of an entry permit or interim-use permit who has a net family income falling within the federal Social Security Administration poverty guidelines, adjusted by the commission to reflect appropriate cost-of-living differentials, is subject to a maximum annual fee of \$50.
