6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to transferral of tide and submerged
7 lands; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Applications by home rule cities and cities of the first
10 class for conveyances of tide and submerged lands under AS 38.05.320 may be
11 made up to one year after the effective date of this Act if the requirements
12 of sec. 2 of this Act are met. Applications made within one year after the
13 effective date of this Act shall be processed by the director of the division
14 of lands of the Department of Natural Resources or his designee and are
15 otherwise subject to the requirements of AS 38.05.320.

16 * Sec. 2. No home rule city or city of the first class may apply for a
17 conveyance under this Act unless:

18 (1) the city seeks conveyance of tide and submerged lands contig-
19 uous to land which has been used as a public park for at least 45 years; and

20 (2) the land used as a park was granted to the city by the United
21 States for the purpose of use as a public park.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
