6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to surplus property; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.71.030(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The functions of the Department of Administration under
11 secs. 20 - 40 of this chapter shall be, to the fullest extent possible,
12 self-supporting. Funds to pay for personal services and all other
13 expenses necessary to operate under secs. 20 - 40 of this chapter
14 shall be obtained from appropriations authorized under secs. 20 - 40
15 of this chapter and fees charged to users of surplus property. [HOW-
16 EVER, NO CHARGES MAY BE MADE WHEN PROPERTY IS TRANSFERRED FOR CIVIL
17 DEFENSE PURPOSES.] The department shall establish the fees to be
18 charged. Charges may be made to reimburse the department for direct
19 costs incurred on behalf of users of surplus property.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
