6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending general requirements of state person-
7 nel rules to define temporary employment requirements."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(9) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (9) temporary appointments to positions in the state service
11 which are determined to be of a seasonal or temporary nature; provisions
12 of the personnel rules with respect to temporary employment shall re-
13 quire that

14 (A) except as otherwise provided in written agreements
15 between the state and its public employees which are in effect on
16 the effective date of this Act or as otherwise provided in any
17 renewal of those agreements, temporary appointments shall be made
18 only from eligible lists for appointment;

19 (B) temporary appointments shall meet the minimum quali-
20 fications required of individuals seeking permanent employment in
21 the class into which they are to be hired;

22 (C) waiver of the requirements of (A) and (B) of this
23 paragraph may be granted by the director as to any temporary
24 appointment but that, if granted, each waiver shall be accompanied
25 by a written statement providing reasons for the waiver and the
26 statement shall be a public document; and

27 (D) temporary appointments to positions in state service
28 may not exceed 10 per cent of the total number of classified state
29 employees;
