6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations with respect to
7 certain utilities and the Legislative Council; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$356,693 is appropriated from the general fund as
11 a grant to the City of Nome to reimburse Nome Joint Utilities, a municipal
12 utility system of the city, for extraordinary capital expenditures incurred
13 by it in response to the natural disaster of November 14, 1974, and which
14 have not been otherwise provided for from federal and state sources.

15 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$192,743 is appropriated from the general fund to be
16 apportioned as follows:

17 (1) \$52,743 to the City of Seward to reimburse the city for its
18 expenditures to meet extraordinary expenses incurred as a result of damage to
19 the city transmission line on May 18, 1977;

20 (2) \$140,000 to the Department of Transportation and Public Facil-
21 ities to relocate the principal transmission line serving the City of Seward
22 in conjunction with realignment of the roadway at Mile 18.1 of the Seward
23 Highway.

24 (3) \$75,000 to the Legislative Affairs Council for an interim
25 study of rural energy needs.

26 * Sec. 3. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation
27 made in sec. 2(2) of this Act lapses into the general fund June 30, 1979.

28 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
29 070(c).
