6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to school board elections."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 29.23.310 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 29.23.310. ELECTION. Each borough and city school district
10 has a school board. Members are elected at the regular election held
11 annually on the first Tuesday of October, unless a different election
12 date or interval of years is provided by ordinance, for three-year terms
13 and until their successors take office. All board members are elected
14 at large, and [BUT] school zones for the election of borough school
15 boards may not be established [, ALTERED, OR ABOLISHED AS PROVIDED BY
16 SEC. 100 OF THIS CHAPTER].
