9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.25.040(c) is amended to read:

11 (c) A candidate for a statewide office and a [SHALL FILE WITH THE
12 LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR. A] candidate for a district-wide office shall file
13 either with the lieutenant governor or an election supervisor. If the
14 candidate files his declaration with an election supervisor, the elec-
15 tion supervisor shall immediately forward the declaration to the lieute-
16 nant governor.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
18 070(c).
