IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judicial review of a school board decision which is unfavorable to a teacher."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.205 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.205. JUDICIAL REVIEW. If a school board reaches a decision unfavorable to a teacher, the teacher may seek judicial review by the superior court to determine whether due process was afforded and whether the decision was supported by substantial evidence [IS ENTITLED TO A DE NOVO TRIAL IN THE SUPERIOR COURT]. However, a teacher who has not attained tenure rights is not entitled to judicial review according to this section.
