6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for appeals from personnel actions;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.070(3) is amended to read:

10 (3) hear and determine appeals from any action of personnel
11 or an appointing authority under this chapter and the personnel rules
12 adopted under this chapter, as well as appeals by employees in the
13 classified service as provided in sec. 170 of this chapter;

14 * Sec. 2. AS 39.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

15 Sec. 39.25.173. APPEALS FROM ACTIONS OF DIRECTOR OR APPOINTING
16 AUTHORITY. As to any matter within the scope of this chapter or the
17 personnel rules adopted under this chapter, a person adversely affected
18 or aggrieved by any action of the director of personnel or an appointing
19 authority shall be entitled to appeal to the personnel board. The
20 appeal shall be made within 20 days after notice of the action has been
21 afforded the person and shall be heard in a manner provided by regula-
22 tions adopted by the personnel board under the Administrative Procedure
23 Act (AS 44.62).

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
25 070(c).
