6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to protecting public roads and  
7 highways."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.05.020(3) is amended to read:

10 (3) governing the size, weight, and load limits of all  
11 vehicles operating upon public roads, highways, or bridges, to assure  
12 against undue damage to the road foundations, surfaces, or structures;  
13 and prescribing fees for special permits; a temporary order issued  
14 under sec. 10(4) of this chapter for the purposes of this paragraph is  
15 not considered a regulation and need not be adopted under the Admini-  
16 strative Procedure Act (AS 44.62); such a temporary order is valid only  
17 for 90 days, but may be expressly renewed by the department for one  
18 additional 90-day period. Such regulations and orders are subject to  
19 legislative annulment.
