5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for state veterans'  
7 loans; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 26.15.130(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) persons who served in the armed forces of the United  
11 States for 90 days or more, or whose service was for less than 90 days  
12 because of injury or disability incurred in the line of duty, between  
13 April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, and beginning September 16, 1940  
14 to six months after termination of hostilities involving United States  
15 forces in Indo-China, or in a combat zone during any period of armed  
16 conflict, who were separated from the armed forces with a discharge  
17 other than dishonorable except those veterans who were discharged admin-  
18 istratively for unsuitability, undesirability, unfitness or misconduct  
19 and who are physically present in the state and intend to maintain their  
20 permanent home in the state, and who demonstrate their intent by regis-  
21 tering to vote, designating a location in the state as their home of  
22 record upon official civilian or military personnel records, and obtain-  
23 ing a license to operate a motor vehicle in the state

24 [(A) WHO, AT THE TIME OF INDUCTION INTO THE SERVICE,  
25 WERE RESIDENTS OF THE TERRITORY, WHO HAD BEEN RESIDENTS FOR NOT  
26 LESS THAN ONE YEAR IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THEIR INDUCTION, AND WHO  
27 RETURNED TO THE TERRITORY OR STATE AFTER DISCHARGE AS RESIDENTS  
28 WITH THE INTENTION OF REMAINING IN THE TERRITORY OR STATE; OR

29 (B) WHO, NOT BEING BONA FIDE RESIDENTS OF THE TERRITORY

1 BEFORE THEIR ENTRY INTO THE SERVICE, HAVE BEEN RESIDENTS OF THE  
2 TERRITORY OR STATE FOR FIVE OR MORE YEARS];

3 \* Sec. 2. AS 26.15.160(1)(B) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

4 (B) who are physically present in the state and intend  
5 to maintain their permanent home in the state, and who demonstrate  
6 their intent by registering to vote, designating a location in the  
7 state as their home of record upon official civilian or military  
8 personnel records, and obtaining a license to operate a motor  
9 vehicle in the state; and

10 \* Sec. 3. AS 26.15.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (e) Before approving an application for a loan under this chapter,  
12 the department shall require that a veteran disclose the conditions under  
13 which his discharge was granted.

14 \* Sec. 4. This Act is inapplicable to applications for loans received by  
15 the Department of Commerce and Economic Development before July 1, 1978.

16 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
