6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to medical leave."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 39.20.260(d) is amended to read:

9 (d) When a member of an officer's or employee's immediate family
10 is afflicted with a medical disability requiring the attendance of the
11 officer or employee, or where his presence at his job would jeopardize
12 the health of his follow employees, [AND EITHER OF THESE CONTINGENCIES
13 IS SUPPORTED BY A DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATE,] the officer or employee may,
14 with the consent of the employee's department or agency head, avail him-
15 self of medical leave with pay, within the limits prescribed by this
16 section, the same as if he were personally under a medical disability.
17 If the absence exceeds three working days, the department or agency head
18 may require a doctor's certificate showing the disability.
