6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to campaign disclosure; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15.13.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (i) No contribution may be made and no expenditure may be made or
11 incurred, directly or indirectly, by the state or an entity of the
12 state, to influence the election of a candidate or for or on behalf of
13 a group organized to support or defeat a ballot proposition or question.
14 All other communications which are paid for by the state or an entity of
15 the state and which are related to an election are considered to be in-
16 tended to influence the outcome of an election unless they are only
17 notices of the election or unless they are required by statute or regu-
18 lation. When the state or an entity of the state seeks to influence the
19 outcome of an election, it shall report in the same manner as a group.
20 For the purpose of complying with the requirement in sec. 40(b)(1) of
21 this chapter to list the name and address of each officer and director,
22 the state or an entity of the state shall list the name and address of
23 the governor and the entity's principal officials. For the purpose of
24 complying with the requirement in sec. 40(b)(1) of this chapter to list
25 the name and address of the campaign treasurer, the state or an entity
26 of the state shall list the name and an address of the department or
27 agency's finance director, fiscal officer, or equivalent officer. For
28 the source of contributions required in sec. 70(h) of this chapter, the
29 state or an entity of the state shall list the particular department,

1 division, agency or entity from whose budget the appropriation is made.

2 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
3 070(c).

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
