6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for timber sales; and providing for  
7 an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. From May 1, 1978, to January 1, 1979, the commissioner of  
10 natural resources shall provide for the sale of 250 to 500 M.B.M. or equiv-  
11 alent other measure of timber located in each of at least 20 parcels of state  
12 land. The parcels of state land shall be accessible by highway or road.  
13 Sales shall be by sealed bid, preceded by public notice as provided in AS  
14 38.05.345 and shall include limitations, conditions and terms which the  
15 commissioner considers are in the best interests of the state and which  
16 include the utilization, development and maintenance of the sustained yield  
17 principle, subject to preferences among beneficial users. Sales made under  
18 the authority of this Act are exempt from the provisions of AS 38.05.035(a)-  
19 (14) and 38.05.305.
