6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to nonresident owners of vehicles."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.10.540(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) A person who brings a vehicle subject to registration under
10 this chapter into the state which is registered in another state and who
11 uses the vehicle for pleasure only is exempt from the licensing and
12 registration provisions of this chapter for 90 days after entry into the
13 state. If [THE EXEMPTION DOES NOT APPLY IF] the person becomes gain-
14 fully employed in the state or takes action which indicates his intention
15 to acquire residence in the state, he shall comply with the licensing and
16 registration provisions of this chapter within 15 days of commencement
17 of his employment or of his taking action which indicates his intention
18 to acquire residence.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.200 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (c) The annual license tax payable under (b) of this section shall
21 be doubled if the vehicle to be registered is not registered within the
22 time required for registration of vehicles from another state under sec.
23 540(a) of this chapter.
