6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the fisherman's fund."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 23.35.070 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 23.35.070. BENEFITS. A fisherman, upon becoming disabled,
10 is entitled to receive benefits as follows: Immediately after he
11 sustains an injury or disability arising out of an accident directly
12 connected with his operations as a fisherman, either ashore in the
13 state or in Alaska water [THE TERRITORIAL WATERS OF THE STATE], or
14 suffers an occupational disease, the fisherman is entitled to emergency
15 treatment, transportation to the nearest place where approved medical
16 facilities are available, medical care and hospitalization. As used
17 in this section, "Alaska water" means the inland and territorial water
18 of the state and the fishery conservation zone adjacent to the state
19 established by sec. 101 of the Fishery Conservation and Management Act
20 of 1976, P.L. 94-265 (16 U.S.C. 1801 et seq.).
