6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing an exemption from the minimum wage
7 for individuals employed by a nonprofit organization
8 operating rehabilitation programs; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 23.10.070 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

12 (4) an individual employed by a nonprofit corporation or non-
13 profit organization operating a rehabilitation facility, when the em-
14 ployment is part of a rehabilitation program.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 23.10.145 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (b) In secs. 50 - 150 of this chapter, "rehabilitation facility"
17 means a family home, group care facility, recovery house or similar
18 facility providing group living arrangements for persons recovering from
19 alcoholism or drug abuse where the facility provides care or supervision
20 on a 24-hour basis.

21 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
22 070(c).
