10 Sec. 14.30.180. PURPOSE. It is the purpose of secs. 180 - 350 of  
11 this chapter to provide competent educational [EDUCATION] services for  
12 the exceptional children in the state who are at least three and less  
13 than 22 years of age and for whom the regular school facilities are  
14 inadequate or not available and for individuals 22 years of age and  
15 older when approved by the local school board.
