BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Donald L. McQueen is retiring from his position as deputy commis-

sioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS Captain McQueen's service to the people of Alaska spans a period

12

of more than 20 years in law enforcement positions throughout the state, in-

13

cluding assignment as a trooper in Fairbanks, Haines and Juneau; command of

14

the State Troopers' Northwest Alaska Region and of "C" Detachment in Anchorage;

acting director of the Alaska State Troopers; and two appointments to the

16

position of deputy commissioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, in addition to prior military service and extensive law en-

18

forcement work, Captain McQueen has held active membership or office in law

19

enforcement organizations, including the Alaska Peace Officers Association,

20

the Pacific Northwest National Academy Association, and the International

21

Association of Chiefs of Police; and

WHEREAS Don McQueen is leaving state service on the 15th day of February,

1977, and departs with the best wishes of his department and of all of

24

Alaska's law enforcement agencies and associated organizations;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Captain Donald L.

McQueen is commended for his years of service to the people of the State of

Alaska and congratulated on the occasion of his retirement.
