3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the eleventh annual Boys'
6 State at Fairbanks.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the eleventh annual Boys' State will be held June 5 - 12, 1977,
9 at the University of Alaska, Fairbanks, under the sponsorship of the American
10 Legion and cooperating civic organizations; and

11 WHEREAS this Alaska effort is part of a national program designed to
12 provide delegates with an opportunity to develop an awareness of many of the
13 facets of state and local government; and

14 WHEREAS this week-long exercise in participatory citizenship is made
15 possible by the application of the best elements of volunteer service and
16 free enterprise completely free from government interference and any burden
17 on the taxpayer; and

18 WHEREAS since the legislative portion of the program would be enhanced
19 by the participation of state and local legislators and the availability of
20 materials describing the Alaska legislative process;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends the sponsors
22 of Boys' State for their fine program; encourages business and labor organiza-
23 tions and private citizens to participate in this meritorious endeavor;
24 requests the Legislative Affairs Agency to continue to provide the program
25 with the appropriate legislative publications and have an attorney explain
26 the important bill drafting process to the delegates; and requests the pre-
27 siding officers of each house of the Legislature to encourage members to
28 attend the eleventh annual Boys' State to assist in the legislative portion
29 of the program; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Alaska be requested not to
2 increase fees to Boys' State over the 1976 levels.
