5 Honoring Alice Smith Wilson.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Mrs. Alice Smith Wilson dedicated 37 years of her life in Alaska  
8 to education for youth, advocacy for senior citizens, and service to her  
9 community, serving in the capacities of school teacher in Kaltag, principal  
10 in Fort Yukon and North Pole, president of the Alaska Retired Teachers Associa-  
11 tion, secretary-treasurer of Senior Citizens of Interior Alaska, and a member  
12 of the Fairbanks North Star Borough Planning and Zoning Commission; and

13 WHEREAS Mrs. Wilson was an incessant activist, speaking out against  
14 expanding government, wasted tax dollars, and political corruption, a leader  
15 of the successful fight against an urban renewal project that would have  
16 evicted elderly Fairbanks residents, and a believer in people power; and

17 WHEREAS her civic leadership earned for her the love of her friends and  
18 allies, the respect of her opponents, and wide renown; and

19 WHEREAS Alice Smith Wilson recently passed away;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the memory of Mrs.  
21 Alice Smith Wilson is honored for her dedication to people and her service to  
22 Alaska, and the Legislature extends its sympathy to her husband, Herbert  
23 Wilson.
